AIM Program Accelerated Industrial Maintenance Certificate

The AIM Certificate consists of three courses from Blackhawk Technical College: Mechanics of Learning, Safety (OSHA 30 General Industry Certificate), and Troubleshooting Integrated Manufacturing Systems 1 (TIMS). These one-credit courses offer a strong foundation of skills for individuals pursuing careers in manufacturing. Additionally, participants will have the chance to explore career opportunities in the field at local manufacturing companies.
